To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Thomas W. Messick, a citizen of the United States, and a resident of Mattoon, Coles County, Illinois, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Fishing Lure, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof, in which:

Fig. 1 is a top plan view of a fishing lure, showing my new design;

Fig. 2 is a side elevation;

Fig. 3 is a bottom plan view;

Fig. 4 is a right-end elevation of Fig. 1; and

Fig. 5 is a left-end elevation of Fig. 1.

The ring and hook shown in broken lines in Fig. 1 have been omitted from Figs. 2, 3, 4, and 5 for convenience of illustration.

The essential feature of my design resides in the lure body shown in full lines. I claim:

The ornamental design for a fishing lure, substantially as shown and described.
